Our Commitment to Transparency

OCCF believes in transparency and accountability to its constituents and the public by making available information on OCCF's governance structure, governance policies and documents, financial condition as reflected in audited financial statements, and major programs.

This policy implements Internal Revenue Service requirements regarding public disclosure of MNA's IRS form 1023 exemption application and annual reporting IRS forms.

Information Available to the Public

OCCF shall post on its website, www.owencountycf.org and make available upon request the following information and documents in a timely manner:

1. Governance Documents, including:
 - a. A list of the current officers and directors of OCCF
 - b. Articles of Incorporation
 - c. Bylaws
 - d. Confidentiality Policy
 - e. Conflict of Interest Policy
 - f. Nondiscrimination Policy
 - g. Public Disclosure Policy
 - h. Whistleblower Policy
2. Financial and IRS documents, including:
 - a. IRS form 1023 exemption application
 - b. IRS form 990 and 990T
 - c. Audited financial statements

Documents requested will be provided within 5 business days. The Board Chair and CEO will authorize provision of such documents. No documents will be concealed, altered, or destroyed with the intent to obstruct the investigation or litigation.
