Grant Type	Description	Value	Timeline
Nonprofit Scholarships	Provides a nonprofit with a one-year membership to the chamber.	\$65	Year-Round
Teacher Mini-Grants	Designed to enhance the classroom learning of S-OCS students.	\$50-\$300 (funds may be pooled with other teachers for large-scale projects)	Year-Round
Cancer Support Grants	Provides support to a qualified family with children in which one of the immediate family members is battling cancer	\$150 - \$1,000+ Depends on available, spendable funding at the time of request	Year-Round
Rapid Response Grants	Provides support to nonprofits in need of emergency assistance.	\$1,000	Year-Round Rapid Response Grants are on a first-come, first-served basis. A nonprofit may only receive ONE Rapid Response Grant per calendar year.
Nonprofit Operating Assistance Grants	Provides grants of up to \$1,000 for nonprofit operations or programming.	\$1,000	Year-Round A nonprofit may only receive ONE Nonprofit Operating Assistant Grant -OR- ONE Rapid Response Grant per calendar year.
Food Pantry Assistance Grants	Assists with emergency food and shelter programs to purchase food for Owen County residents.	\$500 - \$7,500+	Application Opens: January 1 Round 1 Deadline: March 31 If funds remain available, the grant application may reopen for requests through September 30.
Community Investment Grants (CIGs)	Provides funding to nonprofits that are implementing projects or programs that will support a strong and vibrant Owen County community.	\$1,001 - \$5,000	Application Opens: January 1 Round 1 Deadline: March 31 If funds remain available, the grant application may reopen for requests through September 30.
Large Impact Grants (LIGs)  <b>NO LIG CYCLE IN 2025</b>	The largest recurring grant at OCCF. Supports funding for major projects and programs in the community. Priority areas: access to information, parks & recreation, and childcare/early childhood education.	\$10,000 - \$30,000	January 1 – Intent to Apply Open (Round I) February 21 – Intent to Apply Closes (Round I) March 1 – Application Opens (Round II) March 31 – Application Closes (Round II) April 12 – LIG Presentations to Committee
Education Grant	Enhance educational outcomes for PK-12 students and improve preparation for post-secondary education.	Project dependent	Year-Round
